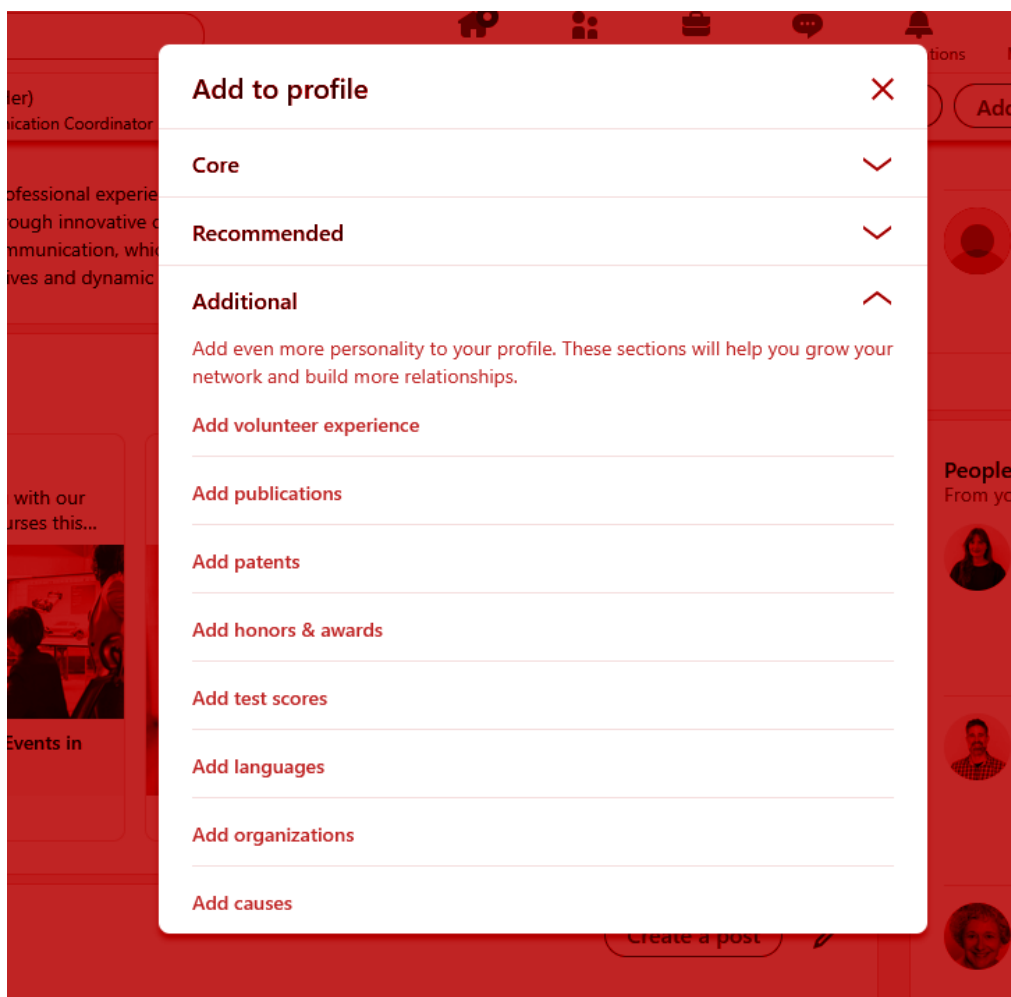
How to add your volunteer work on LinkedIn
